#### Please Read Carefully:

1. Interconnection of properties is prohibited.
  2. A shut off valve going into the residence and/or business is required by the District.
  3. All internal and external plumbing shall comply with the Pueblo Regional Building and Colorado Department of Health & Environment Primary Drinking Water Regulations.
  4. Service line between the meter and the house shall not be smaller than one (1) inch in diameter.
  5. The minimal monthly service charge for each tap shall commence thirty (30) days after payment of the tap fee.

##### Chapter 4

##### Plumbing

(2) All new or replaced water service piping fewer than two (2) inches (51 mm) from the main to the meter shall be no lighter than Type L Copper or PEX, PE-Al-PE, and PEX-AL-PEX pipe. A blue 14-gauge tracer wire shall be installed with all non-metallic water services. All service piping two (2) inches (51 mm) or larger shall be type K Cooper, Class 50 or Ductile Iron, or PVC American Water Works Association approved pressure pipe or other approved material. Water service piping shall be installed to a minimum of forty-eight (48) inches (1.219.2 mm) depth from the top of the pipe.

#### C. METER YOKES

Residential service lines are generally considered to be low-hazard connections, unless a hazardous activity is present. Meter yokes with a dual check valve assembly will be installed on new taps and service upgrades. Additional protection is required for irrigation systems or other hazardous situations.

The District will require that a Thermal Expansion Absorber be installed inside the residence to control any thermal expansion caused by the hot water heater. The District recommends an ST-5 THERM-X-TROL or approved equal.
